Barbeques in Ferry Meadows

Permanent BBQ stands are available on a first come, first served basis at the following locations in Ferry Meadows:

- Two stands at Coney Meadow Pond on the west side of the main car park
- Two stands overlooking Gunwade Lake by the Lakeside car park
- Two stands by the miniature railway platform overlooking Lynch Lake

You are welcome to bring your own BBQs providing that you follow the guidelines. You will also require your own fuel and utensils.



Barbeque guidelines

Please follow a few simple guidelines so that both you and other visitors can enjoy their visit to the Park.

Consider others and site your BBQ so smoke does not affect other visitors

Site your BBQ clear from paths, vegetation, buildings and structures

BBQs should be raised off the ground and never placed on picnic tables or benches

Ensure the surface is flat and stable before lighting

Keep water near to cool the BBQ after cooking or to extinguish it should a problem arise

Use only enough charcoal to cover the base of the BBQ to a depth of about 5cms (2 inches) to prevent excessive fire and hot ash build up

Never use petrol or paraffin to start or revive your BBQ

Use only recognized lighters or starter fuel, on cold coals

Gas BBQs are not permitted

All litter must be taken away or placed in the bins provided.

Hot ashes and disposable BBQs must be sufficiently cooled with water before disposal.
